## From Dream to Reality

### Face to face inspiration

The best project often evolves when you meet with colleagues and associates. This gives people the opportunity to exchange ideas, share best practice and find new inspiration.

### Explore and develop

Taking place in a transnational and interdisciplinary setting, the course offers you an unique possibility to explore and develop your project ideas in a creative and innovative forum.

### Combined competences

This course will link the use of creative and innovative tools within project development to practical transnational experiences and professional networking.

### Innovation

The aim is to provide the participants with tools, to inspire them to set off innovation processes and enable them to transform project ideas into qualified projects.

### Methodical approach

Appreciative Inquiry (AI) will be the methodical framework for the course. AI focuses on resources rather than limits and is a well documented method to creative positive development.

### Participants

The course is open to all working in the field of adult education and social inclusion direct or indirect, experienced or inexperienced.

### Course organizer

The course is provided by "PSgruppen", an organization with many years of experience in national and transnational project development and fundraising within the fields of adult education and social inclusion.

## Training Programme

### Day 1

#### Introduction

The first day will focus on a presentation of the participants, their project ideas and experiences. The participants will discuss the prospects for projects in their local area as well as in their home country.

### Day 2

#### From dream to idea – innovation

During the day the participants will be introduced to different tools focusing on possibilities rather than barriers. These tools will help you promote innovation processes and transform dreams into realistic ideas.

### Day 3

#### From idea to project

The day will lead the participants through different stages in project development and design. We will discuss how a competitive proposal can be made and the importance of having a unique selling points.

### Day 4

#### Fundraising and political agendas

To make a project come true it is important to know the political agenda and have a fruitful cooperation with the various partners. In other words; how to analyze political agendas and lobby for your project.

### Day 5

#### Networking

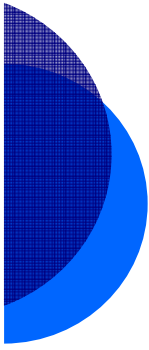
Besides discussing how to use networking in project development, the new network established during the week will be formalised and the participants introduced to the European project network – P.A.L.S.
